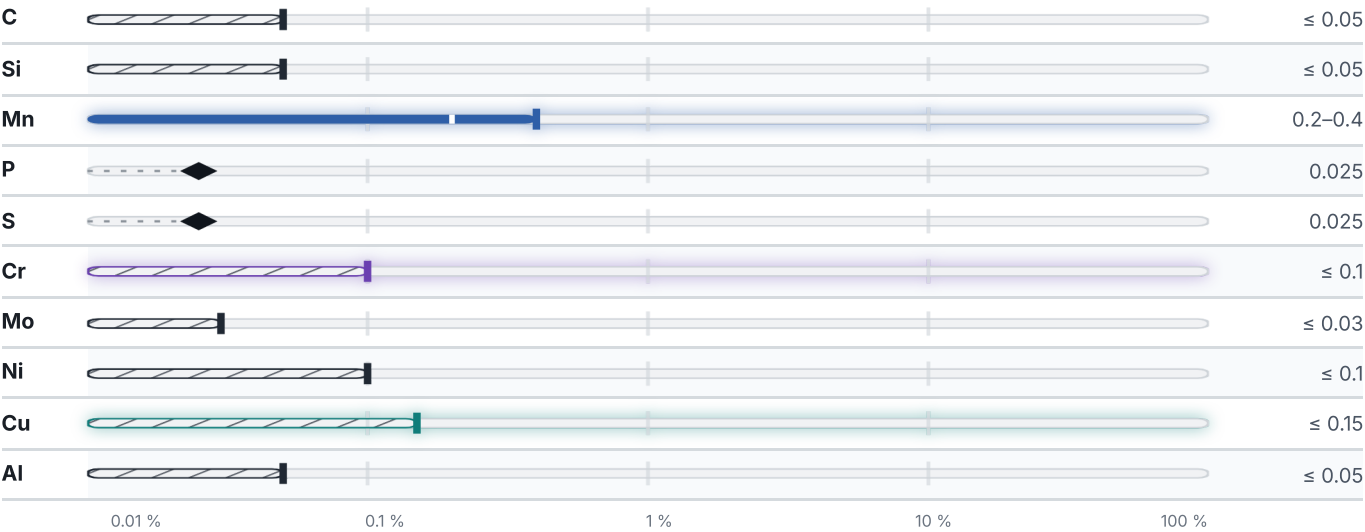

● Iron — the balance, never listed by a standard — 99.1 % ● Mn — 0.3 % ● Cu — 0.2 % ● Cr — 0.1 % ● Traces & impurities · 0.3 %

Logarithmic scale, 0.01 % to 100 % — every value here compares directly, decade by decade.



The scale is logarithmic, not the element's raw share of the alloy — the only honest way to fit 0.01 % and 100 % in one picture, and it means every value here can be compared with every other.
