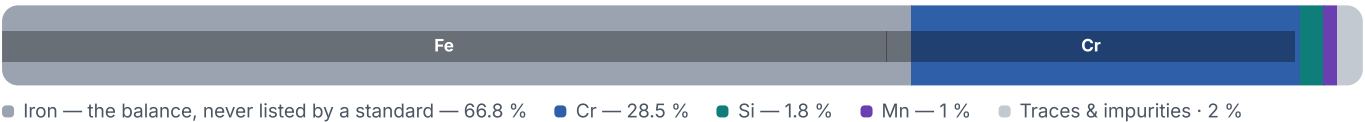

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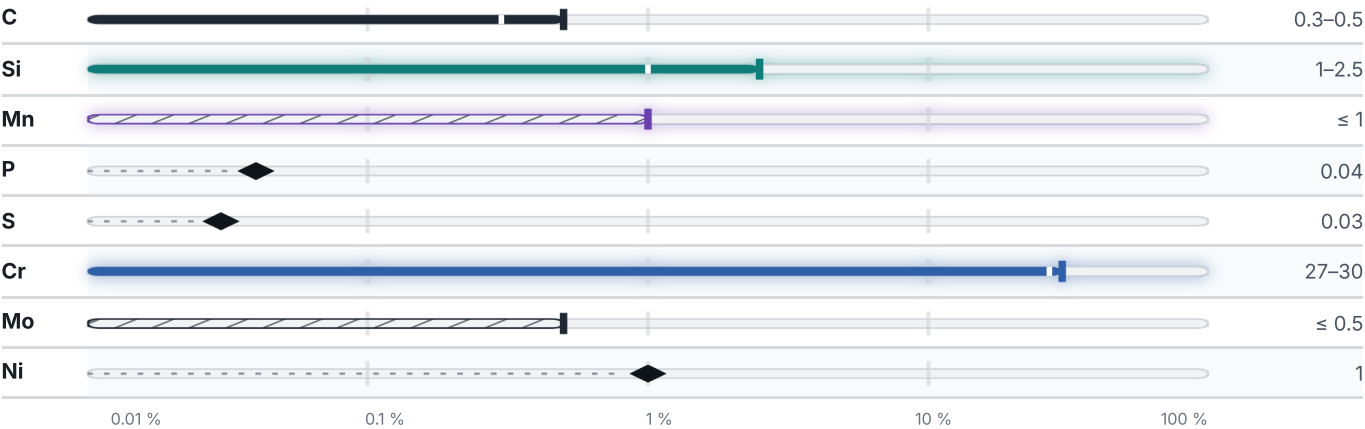

Logarithmic scale, 0.01 % to 100 % — every value here compares directly, decade by decade.



The scale is logarithmic, not the element's raw share of the alloy — the only honest way to fit 0.01 % and 100 % in one picture, and it means every value here can be compared with every other.

This grade's composition falls outside the published model's validated range (a low-alloy composition window), so no transformation temperature is predicted here.
