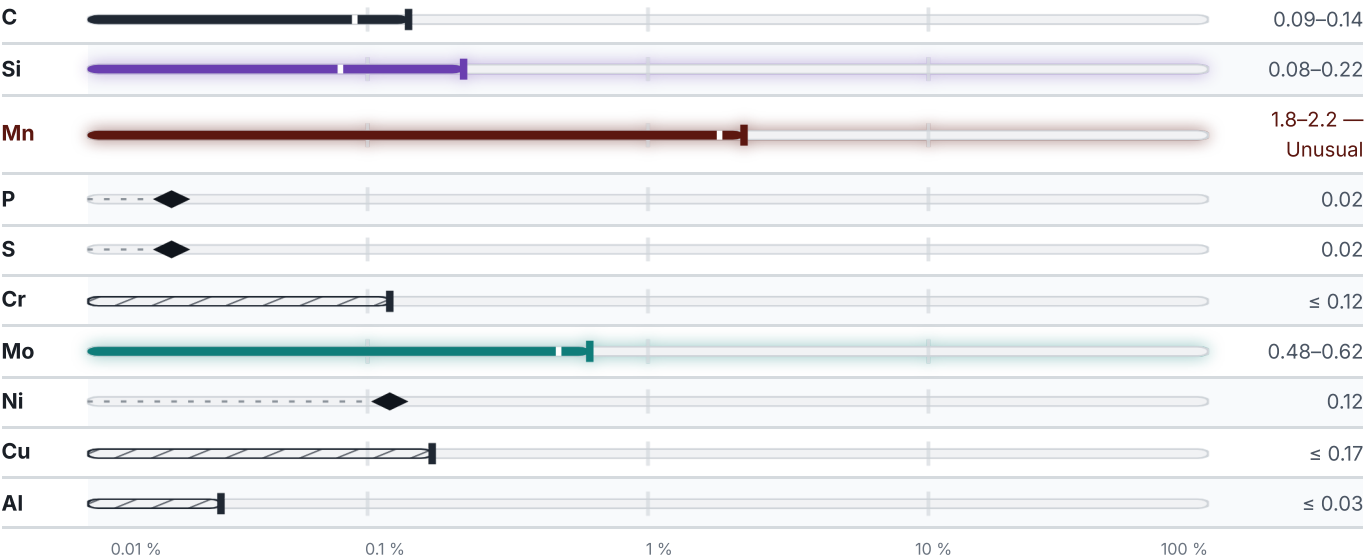

● Iron — the balance, never listed by a standard — 96.7 % ● Mn — 2 % ● Mo — 0.6 % ● Cu — 0.2 % ● Traces & impurities · 0.6 %

Logarithmic scale, 0.01 % to 100 % — every value here compares directly, decade by decade.



The scale is logarithmic, not the element's raw share of the alloy — the only honest way to fit 0.01 % and 100 % in one picture, and it means every value here can be compared with every other.
